PROJECT STARTING

The Twinning "Support to the State Customs Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan in the accession to the Convention on a Common Transit Procedure, Convention on Simplification of Formalities in Trade in Goods and implementation of the New Computerised Transit System (NCTS)" officially started on the 1st of June 2020.

The duration of the project is **15 months** and the **budget** is **EUR 1 million.**

The Member State implementing partner of the Twinning is the Italian Customs and Monopolies Agency, supported, for the financial and administrative part, by Studiare Sviluppo (as Mandated body).

The overall objective of the project is to facilitate Azerbaijan's connectivity with existing EU customs systems and to provide simplifications for trade facilitation among EU and Azerbaijan.

The specific objective of the project is to assist the State Customs Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan in setting up the relevant legal, administrative and technical environment to support the accession of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the Convention of 20 May 1987 on the Simplification of Formalities in Trade in Goods, the Convention of 20 May 1987 on a common transit procedure and preparing for the implementation of the New Computerised Transit System (NCTS).

PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

The **first Project Steering Committee**, that approved the first Quarterly Report and the first Rolling workplan, was held on the 4th of September.

The meeting was attended by the two Project Leaders (MS and BC) and the two RTAs, by the Project Manager of the Mandated body, Studiare Sviluppo, by the EU Delegation Project Manager, by MoE Representative, Component leaders from both Customs administrations and project assistants.



PROJECT PREPARATION

Despite the impact that COVID Pandemic had over the project preparation phase, the first Rolling work-plan has been prepared remotely, jointly with the Beneficiary.

Also the selection process of the two assistants has been conducted by remote, while the Beneficiary started identifying the office space, equipping it with computers, Internet connection, phones, copy machine, printer, scanner and all the facilities for the twinning team.




















STARTING OF ACTIVITIES

The first activity planned in the work-plan, consisting in the legislative assessment of the transit sector in Azerbaijan, was duly started on September 7, followed by the beginning of the assessment of transit procedures and IT component, to conclude, as of today, with the analysis of the organization of the Beneficiary in relation to transit customs procedure, which represent, all together, the main lines of development of the twinning.

At the moment, the activities are carried out remotely, waiting to be able to resume them in the traditional way, with the missions of the experts in the country.

In addition to the virtualization of activities, which strongly clashes with the successful principles and methods of twinning, the experts have tried to maximize the use of the digital platform in use, both by extending the number of participants and by giving rise to interactive sessions, through visualization in real time of the procedures, in use in Azerbaijan and in the EU, in the transit field.


